
What is a School Based Health Center?

- Mental Health services
- Located on school campus but confidential and separate from school
- Convenient access to health care for students
- Consent from parents per state laws
- Medical providers coordinate with student's Primary Care Provider






Overview: SBHC Sponsors and Partners






East Jefferson County's SBHC Historical Perspective






Blue Heron/OCEAN SBHC - Current and Projected Timeline






Number of Clinic Users and Visits by Grade






Percent Utilization by Grade







Mental Health Users by Gender










Percent MH Users by Grade






Top Reasons for SBHC Mental Health Visits


