









Quick Start Guide for Chromebook

<p>1. Charge Chromebook. Locate port on device. Insert port without bending the metal tip and plug it in.</p>	
<p>2. Turn power on. Open the lid. Press power button.</p>	
<p>3. Connect to WiFi. Select your family's network. Enter your family's network password.</p>	
<p>4. Add Person* (*If you do not see this, move to next step) Click on "Add Person". "Browse as Guest" will not give you access to school apps.</p>	
<p>5. Sign In. Enter your school gmail, click "Next". Enter your secure password*, click next.</p> <p>*Your password will be provided for on a separate sheet of paper. Ask for assistance if you did not receive it. Please keep this information in a secure place.</p>	
<p>6. Click Launcher. Click on the launcher icon located in the bottom left corner of the screen, to see apps listed below.</p>
