Washington State Requirements

Washington State requires all schools that provide sexual health education to use speakers, curriculum and materials that are medically and scientifically accurate, age appropriate, appropriate for students regardless of gender, race, sexual orientation, and disability status, and otherwise in compliance with the provisions of the law per RCW 28A.300.475. The Family Life and Sexual Health (FLASH), KNOW and 3R curriculum are used by Port Townsend School District in grades 5-12, meets the provisions of the Healthy Youth Act, as well as requirements in the AIDS Omnibus Act.

Optional Opt-Out

Per parent request, a student may be removed from Human Growth & Development and HIV/AIDS education if the student's parent or guardian, having attended this meeting then completes the opt-out form. The form is due by **Wednesday**, **October 18th**.

If you decide to opt your child out of the curriculum, please be mindful of your responsibility, as the parent, to provide appropriate HGD information to your child. Opting out will not prevent their curiosity, and if they aren't hearing it from their teacher, know that they may be hearing it second hand from their classmates, so making sure they get accurate information is important.

The opt-out form is good for one year (current grade level) only. Parents will need to continue to attend the presentations, review the curriculum and complete the opt-out form each year, if desired.
